

Effective Friday, March 13, 2020, Dharma Field is temporarily suspending all social gatherings in response to COVID-19

The World Health Organization has declared the rapid spread of COVID-19 a pandemic. Given this news, Dharma Field has suspended all social gatherings until further notice. This includes daily sittings, Sunday talks, classes, discussion groups, and the spring practice period. (Just a reminder, though, we have hundreds of talks on our website that are available to members and audio subscribers.) As we continue to monitor the situation, we'll be posting updates on our policy as the situation changes.

To give you a sense of the seriousness of what we're facing, the latest research shows that the coronavirus is spread through the air and not merely through person to person contact as was previously thought. They have also learned that the virus can survive on metal or plastic surfaces for up to 3 days. This is why this particular virus is so dangerous, and why our best option to slow its spread in our community is to cancel all social gatherings NOW—as many other organizations have been doing across the country. The situation is not yet critical in Minnesota, so this is our best opportunity to slow the spread of the virus before it gets out of hand. If we wait until things get worse, it will be too late to make much of a difference.
